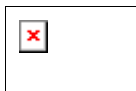
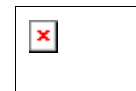


International 14 World Team Championships

Notice of Race

1. **Rules** - The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing; the rules of the International 14 Class; the Team Racing Rules, rule D; except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions. There will no Umpires or Observers.

2. **Advertising** - The regatta is designated Category B in accordance with rule 79 and rule G.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to yachts of the International 14 class that hold a current measurement certificate.

3.2 One team per country may enter. An additional team may be allowed, so that there will be an even number of teams.

3.3 A team shall consist of a maximum of five boats, any four of which may compete in a given race.

5.2 Registration shall be postmarked no later than August 1st 1997.

6. Fees

6.1 **Entry fee** - US\$400 per team

6.2 **USAA Regatta insurance fee** - US40 (Fee is waived if you are a member of your national sailing association.)

7. **Measurement** - Each yacht shall submit a valid measurement certificate and measurements will be taken.

8. **Sailing Instructions** - sailing instructions will be available at sign in.

9. **Regatta Site** - The regatta site will be as shown in location "A", attached (Pt. Richmond California.)

10. **Racing Area** - The racing area will be as shown in location "B", attached (in the region of the Berkeley Olympic Circle).

11. **Decisions of the Jury** - Decisions of the Jury will be final in accordance with rule 70.4.

12. **Prizes** - As per tradition, there will be no prizes for the Team race competition.
