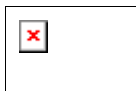
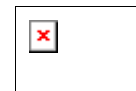

Notice of Race

1. **Rules** - The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the rules of the International 14 Class, except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions.

2. **Advertising** - The regatta is designated Category B in accordance with rule 79 and rule G.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to yachts of the International 14 class that hold current measurement certificates.

3.2 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Entries will be limited to the first 120 entries received in compliance with the registration requirements of section 5.

6. **Fees**

6.1 **Entry fees**

US\$325 if postmarked no later than June 1, 1997.

US\$450 if postmarked after June 1, 1997.

6.2 **USAA Regatta insurance fee** (Fee is waived if you are a member of your national sailing association.)

US\$32.50 if postmarked no later than June 1, 1997.

US\$45 if postmarked after June 1, 1997.

7. **Measurement** - Each yacht shall submit a valid measurement certificate and measurements will be taken.

8. **Sailing Instructions** - sailing instructions will be available at sign in.

9. **Regatta Site** - The regatta site will be as shown in location "A", attached (Pt. Richmond California.)

10. **Racing Area** - The racing area will be as shown in location "B", attached (in the region of the Berkeley Olympic Circle).

11. **Scoring** - The Low-point scoring System, rule A of the racing rules, will apply.

12. **Alternative Penalties** - The 720 Turns penalty, Appendix B1 of the racing rules, will apply.

13. **Decisions of the Jury** - Decisions of the Jury will be final in accordance with rule 70.4.

14. **Prizes** - Prizes will be awarded to each member of the crews placing first through tenth in the regatta. A prize will be awarded to each crew member of the top placing crew sailing an "old rules" boat, adhering to the rules in effect prior to January 1996.
